Stain Removal Q&A

My kids' clothes really get dirty during the summer. What is the best way to treat stains?

Grass: Use a pretreat laundry product then launder as soon as possible. Be sure to check the garment to see if the stain was removed before you dry it. If not, try again. Drying a garment with a stain still in it will only make it more difficult or impossible to get rid of.

Mud: Let the mud dry. Then brush off as much mud as possible. Treat the stain using a pretreat product and launder.

Blood: For fresh stain, soak in cold water (hot water will set the stain). Then launder. For dried stains pretreat or soak in solution of warm water and launder.
